Thank you for your email of 24 February 2024 which contained your request for information. The Government Legal Department (“GLD”) have processed your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (“the Act”) / [the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (“the Regulations”).

The Black's legal dictionary defines Driver as someone acting under commerce, I assume that if not being paid or acting under commerce then, the definition does not fit and we become travellers, Not Drivers, the law states travellers can travel without fee let or hindrance.

1: please define driver

2: please define traveller.

If I am not driving, then what statutes apply, as a recent ticket is refusing to accept the legal difference,

3: Am I allowed to travel the roads in a car without a licence.

Response
