Response

In accordance with Section 1(1)(a) of the Act, GLD can confirm that it does hold the information you have requested.

GLD is aware that you have also asked the Home Office for the following:

How much has been spent in legal costs associated with the following case? Please provide any detailed breakdown available.

The case reference is: AA & Others v SSHD AC-2023-LON-001561 and HT & Others v SSHD AC-2023-LON-001649. It case relates to a judicial review application by two groups of asylum seekers seeking an Article 3 ECHR compliant inquiry into events at the Manston short term holding facility.

GLD understands that the Home Office has provided you with a response. Under s21 of the Act, even though GLD does hold the information, because you already have the requested information, GLD does not need to provide you with this again.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review.
