the following judgment is made by consent:

1. The Respondent do pay the First Claimant the sum of £19,121.36 comprising of:

1.1£1,121.36 pecuniary loss (subject to deductions for tax and national

insurance);

1.2£18,000 for injury to feelings. The parties are of the view this will be free of

tax.

Mr Acosta Piamonte

2. The Respondent do pay the Second Claimant the sum of £19,170.12 comprising

of:

2.1 £1,170.12 pecuniary loss (subject to deductions for tax and national

insurance);

2.2 £18,000 for injury to feelings. The parties are of the view this will be free of

tax.

Ms Ferreira

3. The Respondent do pay the Third Claimant the sum of £14,046.97 comprising

of:

3.1 £4,046.97 pecuniary loss (subject to deductions for tax and national

insurance);

3.2 £10,000 for injury to feelings. The parties are of the view this will be free of

tax.

Ms Gusque

4. The Respondent do pay the Fourth Claimant the sum of £17,046.97 comprising

of:

4.1£4,046.97 pecuniary loss (subject to deductions for tax and national insurance);

4.2£13,000 for injury to feelings. The parties are of the view this will be free of tax.

Ms Fonnegra Rivera

5. The Respondent do pay the Fifth Claimant the sum of £18,046.97 comprising of:

5.1 £4,046.97 pecuniary loss (subject to deductions for tax and national insurance);

5.2 £14,000 for injury to feelings. The parties are of the view this will be free of tax.

Ms Yaguar Salinas

6. The Respondent do pay the Sixth Claimant the sum of £14,046.97 comprising of:

6.1 £4,046.97 pecuniary loss (subject to deductions for tax and national insurance);

6.2 £10,000 for injury to feelings. The parties are of the view this will be free of tax.

7. The total sum being owed to all six claimants is £101,479.36.

8. The Respondent is to pay the sums specified within a period of 28 days following the date of this judgment being sent to the parties.
