Thank you for your email of 1 July 2024 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requesting the following information:

"I am applying to you under the Freedom of Information legislation for further information on my Uncle Leslie Stancliff.

I applied to Royal Navy Search requesting Record of Service for Leslie Stancliff who served in WW2 and sadly was Missing Presumed Killed in Action on 16th January 1945 Ship President III (M.V. Magdala)

They sent me information on his record of service including a sheet which gave details of Ribbons Issued.

However I would like to know if the ribbons/medals were sent to his wife/ family/next of kin or if they can still be issued to his surviving family.

These were as follows: 1949-1945 STAR ATLANTIC PACIFIC 0922/99? FRANCE & GERMANY WAR MEDAL"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

Records confirm that Leslie Stancliff's awards were issued on 29 January 1951 to his widow who was the next of kin at the time.
