### Diplomacy

UK-Ukraine <u>100 Year Partnership</u> fosters cross-sector collaboration incl. defence & security, science & tech, economy & trade [16 Jan]

Supported <u>UNGA resolutions</u> condemning Russia's: invasion [Mar 22, Feb 23]; attempted annexation of 4 Ukrainian regions [Oct 22]; & attacks on Ukraine's energy infrastructure [Jul 24]

We use the UNSC to hold Russia to account & reaffirm support for Ukraine. FS used Presidency to mark <u>1000 days of invasion</u> [18 Nov]

At OSCE, we call out Russia weekly & co-fund Support Programme for Ukraine. <u>4 fact-finding missions</u> reported on human rights abuses. At <u>Annual Ministerial Council</u> we called for increased support [6 Dec]

At IAEA, we support efforts towards nuclear safety in Ukraine

#### Military

£7.8bn total support, including £3bn for 2024/25

Committed £3bn a year until 2030/31 & for as long as it takes [10 Jul]

 $\underline{\pounds 2.26bn}$  contribution to G7 ERA Loans, to be repaid with profits from Russian assets. Legislation has now received Royal Assent [16 Jan]

Sent approx. 400 different capabilities to Ukraine incl. new £225m package incl. drones, boats & munitions [19 Dec], 650 LMM missiles [6 Sep] & package of military equipment [7 Jul]

UK & Latvia-led drone coalition to deliver 30,000 new attack & surveillance drones [9 Jan]. UK invested £7.5m [19 Nov]

UK & Denmark joint-funding bespoke air defence system [16 Jan]

<u>UK/Ukraine Defence Industrial Support Treaty</u> expands list of military equipment that can be funded via £3.5bn UK Export Finance [19 Jul]

Over 51,000 Ukrainian personnel trained under Operation INTERFLEX. Scheme <u>extended</u> until at least end 2025 [6 Sep]. 180 soldiers to receive <u>combat mental resilience training</u> in 2025 [28 Dec]

UK-administered International Fund for Ukraine procures equipment: <u>>£1.3bn</u> pledged to date, incl. <u>£300m ammunition order</u> [10 Jul]

### Non-military

£5bn in non-military commitments since Feb 22. This includes:

- $\underline{\text{£4.1bn}}$  in fiscal support through World Bank loan guarantees
- £977m in bilateral assistance. £282m in 2024/25 funds reform, humanitarian, energy, recovery & reconstruction programmes

## Humanitarian

 $\underline{\pounds477m}$  total assistance to Ukraine and the region, incl.  $\underline{at \ least \ \pounds120m}$  in humanitarian assistance in 2024/25 [11 Sep]

<u>£15m</u> will support those most in need this winter [17 Dec]


We have committed £12.9 million to HALO Trust for demining, incl. <u>£4.3m</u> for 2025/26. Over  $350,000m^2$  land cleared (May 22 to Sep 24)

# **Recovery & Reconstruction**

Co-hosted <u>Ukraine Recovery Conference 2023</u>, raising over \$60bn War risk insurance via MIGA & <u>EBRD</u> boosts inward investment > $\pm$ 500m via UKEF for reconstruction, energy & defence projects Up to  $\pm$ 30m via British International Investment, working with <u>EBRD</u> to offer trade finance to support critical imports/exports. [11 Sep] 38m Good Governance Fund tackles corruption & supports reform New  $\pm$ 40m economic recovery programme helps SMEs [16 Jan]

### Energy

Over  $\pounds$ 390m for energy security and resilience through grant, inkind support and loan guarantees

A further  $\underline{\text{\pounds 20m}}$  to support emergency energy needs takes total support to the Ukraine Energy Support Fund to  $\pounds$ 84m [17 Dec]

 $\underline{$  £181m from UKEF for Urenco to supply enriched uranium to power Ukraine & maintain its independence from Russian fuel [18 Jul]

 $\underline{\texttt{£16m}}$  to support UK and Ukrainian innovators through UK's Innovate Ukraine Green Energy Competition [2 May]

### Sanctions

>2,100 individuals and entities sanctioned, incl. 1,900 since full-scale invasion

UK, US and EU sanctions have deprived Russia of over \$400bn since Feb 2022 - equivalent to ~3 more years funding for the invasion Since imposition of Oil Price Cap, Russian data shows a 30% reduction in tax revenues from oil in 2023, compared to year before

IMF forecasts reduction in growth from 3.6% in 2024 to 1.3% in 2025

This Government has imposed sanctions against:

- 2 of Russia's 4 largest oil companies, disrupting revenues [10 Jan]

- over 100 ships. Announced sanctions on 20 more tankers in Putin's <u>Shadow Fleet</u> & 2 entities responsible for this reckless trade [17 Dec]

- those forcibly deporting & indoctrinating children [19 Nov]

- Russia's <u>military industrial complex</u> & private military security groups: 56 new sanctions, largest package since May 2023 [7 Nov]

### War Crimes & Justice

Trade

 $\underline{\texttt{£4.5m}}$  new funding to support Ukraine's domestic war crimes investigations - total funding now £10.7m [29 Dec]

Additional £2.3m to the International Criminal Court

Active member of the <u>'core group'</u> scoping options for achieving accountability for the crime of aggression

Founding member of the <u>International Register of Damage</u> to support claims by Ukrainians who have suffered losses as a result of the war

The UK-Ukraine <u>Digital Trade Agreement</u> entered into force [1 Sep] The UK-Ukraine <u>TechBridge</u> delivers projects in mutual trade,

investment, innovation research and digital skills development Our <u>City-Ukraine Hub</u> leverages UK expertise to deliver capacity building projects

Our military aid and insurance through the UK-developed <u>Unity facility</u> supported the Black Sea <u>maritime corridor</u> enabling Ukraine to <u>export</u> its goods, including all of its 2023 harvest.

UK-Ukraine Political, Free Trade & Strategic Partnership Agreement enables <u>tariff free trade on all goods</u> until 31 March 2029 (eggs & poultry until 31 March 2026) [8 Feb 2024]

### Ukrainians in the UK

218,600 Ukrainians have arrived in the UK, including 159,800 via Homes for Ukraine [as of 16 Dec] <u>Ukraine Permission Extension Scheme</u> to open 4 Feb 2025 [26 Nov] Accommodation, employment, <u>English</u> & skills support provided
