JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The claimant's complaints of suffering detriments caused by making protected disclosures are not well-founded and are dismissed.
- 3. The claimant's complaint of having been treated less favourably because of his race is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 4. The claimant's complaint of suffering harassment related to his race are not well founded and are dismissed.
- 5. The claimant's complaint of victimisation is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 6. The claimant's complaint of failure to provide rest breaks under <u>Regulation 12</u> <u>Working Time Regulations 1998</u> is not well founded and is dismissed.
