JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated **24 June 2024** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations as to why the claim should not be struck out because
 - Under section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 claimants are not entitled to bring a complaint of unfair dismissal unless they were employed for two years or more, except in specific circumstances.
2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing why this should not be done. The claim is therefore struck out.
