- 1. By a letter dated **24 June 2024** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations as to why the claim should not be struck out because
 - Under section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 claimants are not entitled to bring a complaint of unfair dismissal unless they were employed for two years or more, except in specific circumstances.
- 2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing why this should not be done. The claim is therefore struck out.
