## JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The Claimant was not unfairly dismissed by the Respondent and the Claimant's claim of unfair dismissal is dismissed.

2. The Respondent did not fail to make reasonable adjustments for disability pursuant to sections 20 and 21 Equality Act 2010 in respect of the following, and the complaint is dismissed:

- 1. Failing to provide monthly welfare meetings
- 2. Not electronically recording meetings
- 3. Allowing meetings to exceed 30 minutes.
