## **JUDGMENT**

The complaint that the claimant was unfairly dismissed is struck out.

## **REASONS**

- 1. The Claimant complains of unfair dismissal. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years service to make an unfair dismissal complaint.
- 2. The Claimant was employed by the Respondent for less than two years. Therefore, the Claimant is not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 3. The Claimant's reason that the complaint should not be struck out because it relates to unlawful discrimination is not a reason for not striking out the unfair dismissal claim. That is because such complaints about discriminatory dismissals are brought under the Equality Act 2010 not the Employment Rights Act 1996.
- 4. Accordingly, the complaint of unfair dismissal is struck out. The Claimant's discrimination complaints are not affected by this judgment.
