JUDGMENT

- 1. The claim of victimisation (section 27 Equality Act 2010) in relation to allegations 6(I), (III), (IV), (V), (VI), (VIII), (XIII) and (XIV) is well founded and succeeds. The claims were presented within the time limit at section 123 Equality Act 2010.
- 2. All other claims of victimisation (section 27 Equality Act 2010) are not well founded and are dismissed.
- 3. The claim of maternity discrimination (section 18 Equality Act 2010) is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 4. The claim of direct sex discrimination (section 13 Equality Act 2010) is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 5. The respondent must pay to the claimant the agreed sum of £13,000.
