I am writing to oppose the plans to build houses opposite the school in Stebbing.

The village does not have the infrastructure to support any more houses.

The high street is already dangerously busy (particularly during school drop off and pick up times). In part this is because of a lack of paths that connect the surrounding houses to the high street meaning locals are unable to walk.

Adding additional housing is only going to exacerbate this issue and create more dangerous scenarios for children trying to get to and from school.

I cannot see how the high street can facilitate more houses and more cars without serious issues and putting people in danger. You would only have to speak to the school to hear about the problems that already exist.
