JUDGMENT

The unanimous Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is as follows:

- The complaint of discrimination arising from disability is well-founded;
- 2) The complaint of failure to make reasonable adjustments is well-founded;
- 3) The complaint of failure to deal with the flexible working request in a reasonable manner and based on incorrect facts is well-founded;
- 4) The complaint of automatic unfair dismissal for making a flexible working request is not well-founded and is dismissed;
- 5) A remedy hearing will be listed for one day on the first convenient date, subject to the parties informing the Tribunal if they require such a hearing by 9 April 2025.
