JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint of unfair dismissal under the section 94 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The complaint of direct race discrimination under section 13 of the Equality Act 2010 is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 3. The complaint of harassment related to race under section 26 of the Equality Act 2010 is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 4. The claim for breach of contract failure to pay notice pay was conceded by the respondent during the final hearing before Judgment was handed down. The outstanding notice pay has now been paid to the claimant with a payslip to follow.
