JUDGMENT

- 1. The claim of failure to provide reasonable adjustments was in two parts: failure to provide an auxillary aid, namely a stool, and failure to provide an auxillary aid, namely a Roger On hearing device.
- 2. **The complaint relating to the provision of a stool** was not presented within the applicable time limit. It is not just and equitable to extend the time limit. The claim is therefore dismissed.
- 3. The complaint relating to the provision of the Roger On hearing device was brought in time and shall proceed.
- 4. The claim of direct discrimination related to disability or discrimination arising from disability related to two periods: 2018 to 2019, and 2023.
- The complaint relating to 2018 -2019 was not brought in time and it was not just and equitable to extend time. That part of the claim is therefore dismissed.
- 6. The complaint relating to 2023 was not brought in time but it is just and equitable to extend time. That part of the claim shall proceed.
