- 1) The Secretary of State makes this declaration to revoke the surveillance zone that was declared at 14:30 on 07 March 2025 in accordance with articles 4(1)(e) and 36(3) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No. 2) Order 2006<sup>1</sup>.
- 2) This revocation takes effect from 17.00 on 16 March 2025 thereby ending the measures imposed in the 10 kilometre Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference SX0521565343 declared on 07 March 2025, which had replaced the original declaration of a protection and surveillance zone dated 09 February 2025.
