I am a resident in [REDACTED] and would be directly affected by the proposal to turn The Bull Pub into residential property.

Currently the level of traffic through Crews Hole is at an unsustainable level, causing queues and traffic jams throughout the day, at worst during rush hour. There are parts of the road that are one-way and this causes a huge backup of traffic in both directions. This is hazardous for residents - should we need emergency services they would struggle to get to residents in a timely way.

This has been exacerbated by Bristol councils "liveable neighbourhood scheme" which has diverted vast numbers of cars through Crews Hole at the expense of local residents. I am also concerned about the increase in pollution and the impact on the area's children.

Turning The Bull into residential property would vastly increase the level of traffic further and this would put immense pressure on the roads and level of traffic.

Crews Hole does not have any community hub, there is no community centre, local pub or communal setting that serves residents - this would be a much better use of the space.
