I do not agree with the above application. I think it would be bad for the village.

I have lived in the village opposite this area for more than 45 years. I object to this application - the reasons are:

- 1) It is a busy area, with a primary school and very young children everywhere. It would be dangerous for a new entrance to be opposite the school. More traffic and more risk to children.
- 2) the mound is a historical site, enjoyed by residents and visitors to the village. This should not become hidden by housing.
- 3) One of the fields becomes flooded regularly and has [REDACTED] living there.
- 4) We have a Stebbing local plan. We have housing being built in the village. This development is not part of that plan.
- 5) This area of green space is the last bit on the high street, the Downs area. People enjoy walking here and seeing greenery.

Stebbing is a lovely village, we would like it to remain a village and have green spaces.
