The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

Wages

1. The complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages is not well founded and is dismissed.

Holiday Pay

2. The complaint in respect of holiday pay is well-founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant compensation in the sum of £972.72.

Breach of Contract

3. The complaint of breach of contract in relation to notice pay is well-founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant damages in the sum of £138.96.
