## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:
  - 1.1. The claimant's complaint in respect of equal pay is not well-founded and is dismissed. The claimant's work was like work to that of her comparators within the meaning of section 65 Equality Act 2010 but the respondent has shown a material factor defence within the meaning of section 69 Equality Act 2010. The claimant is therefore not entitled to be paid the premium night shift payments that her comparators were paid.
  - 1.2. The claimant's complaint under the Part-Time Workers (Prevention of Less Favourable Treatment) Regulations 2000 is not well-founded and is dismissed. The claimant was not treated less favourably on the ground that she is a part-time worker.
