Environmental Information Regulations – Information Request

We refer to your request for information dated 10 February 2025 which we have dealt with under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

You have requested the following information.

- 1) The annual total for years 2003 to 2023 for the number of Welsh Black cattle issued with passports under Welsh Black (WB) and Welsh Black Cross (WBX) in the UK.
- 2) The age at death on average of WB females.

Please find the information you have requested in the Annex attached to this email.

All data correct as at 12/02/2025.

Please note that the information we have disclosed is for Great Britain, which includes those for England, Scotland and Wales. We are unable to provide figures for Northern Ireland as they use a different cattle tracing system. We cannot provide figures from Northern Ireland giving a whole United Kingdom view therefore this information is not held.

The information you have requested is therefore exempt from disclosure under regulation 12(4)(a) EIR 'Information not held'. This is a qualified exemption, which usually means that a public authority is required to conduct a public interest test to determine whether or not information should be disclosed or withheld. However, the Information Commissioner (IC) takes the view that a public interest test in cases where the information is not held would serve no useful purpose. Therefore, in line with the IC's view RPA has not conducted a public interest test in this case.

If you require the figures for Northern Ireland you will need to request information from Northern Ireland, as follows:

What you need to do

If you are not happy with the way we have handled your request, you can ask for an internal review. These requests should be submitted in writing within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original request. You should email your request for a review to <u>IRT@rpa.gov.uk</u>

If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision by following the link to the Information Commissioner's website <u>here</u>.
