2024 scheme year payments are ongoing, so the above is based on the current position. The RPA expect all payments for the 2024 scheme year to be made by the end of June. Therefore, we have also provided information for the 2023 scheme year as these claims have all been paid.

The county is based on the International Territorial Level information found here - International geographies - Office for National Statistics. Specifically, these are TLD11 and TLD22 for West and East Cumbria respectively and TLC21 for Northumberland.

The location of the WS3 option is based on that of the land parcel itself rather than the business registration address.

The number of applicants paid is based on the number of unique organisations to receive a payment for the WS3 option.

An applicant can have land parcels across geographical boundaries – for example 'Northumberland' and 'Other'. If this is the case, the applicant is included in both categories under 'Number of Applicants Paid', but the amount paid is based on the location of the land parcel i.e. in 'Cumbria' or 'Other'.
