- b) the poultry meat within the commodity for export was obtained from poultry which were submitted to ante and post mortem inspection under veterinary supervision and found to be free from any clinical evidence of infectious or contagious disease of the species;
- c) The slaughterhouse (s) cutting plant(s), processing plant(s) and cold store plant(s) at Section II above are not subject to animal health restrictions arising from Notifiable diseases under United Kingdom law;
- d) the meat/meat products has (have) been dressed, prepared and packed under hygienic conditions in accordance with regulations at present in force in the United Kingdom;
- e) on the basis of legislation currently in force in the United Kingdom, it can be considered that the meat/meat products does (do) not contain levels exceeding the limits permitted in the United Kingdom of any veterinary medicinal product, antiparasitic agent, or heavy metal, metal products or chemical contaminant; and does not contain any beta-agonist or any substances having a thyrostatic, oestrogenic, androgenic or gestogenic action which do not occur naturally in the meat;
- f) the meat originates from poultry not slaughtered as part of a disease eradication program/measure;
- g) the meat/meat products is(are) considered fit for human consumption;
- h) The meat/meat products has(have) been stored at a temperature of -18°C (0°F) or lower at all times after freezing;
- j) The meat/meat products has(have) been exported from the UK within 90 days of the date of slaughter and packing.
