This is the last month UKAMMG will be reporting the All-Pig Price (APP). Due to changes in the pig market structure, the Agriculture Horticulture Development Board (AHDB) has recently decided to stop the All-Pig Price (APP) data series, as the data provided no

longer meets the validation and publication thresholds which are set to protect the confidentiality of the sample and mitigate against competition law risks. AHDB are consulting with the industry to investigate alternative data sources and Defra will update and report to UKAMMG when a decision is made.
