



UK ETS 2025 Baseline Data Collection and applying for HSE/USE status – METS and updated templates

Good afternoon,

The baseline data submission window is now open and will close on 30 June 2025. All installation operators within scope of the UK Emissions Trading Scheme (UK ETS) are required to submit data to their regulator ahead of the next allocation period during this submission window. The baseline data collection is an essential part of the free allocation application and is also used as the application window for Hospital or small emitter (HSE) and Ultra-small emitter (USE) status.

The METS workflow is now available for current HSE and GHGE permit holders to use to submit their baseline data report/ USE/ HSE application to their regulator. Current USEs should submit their reports to their regulator via email.
