## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The Claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is well founded. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 2. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant a basic award of £1607.50
- 3. No compensatory award is payable. The recoupment regulations do not apply.
- 4. The Claimant's claim of direct race discrimination is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 5. The Claimant's claims of harassment related to sex are not well-founded and are dismissed.
- 6. The Claimant's claim of direct sex discrimination regarding the 'husband' comment is out of time and is dismissed because the Tribunal lacks jurisdiction to consider the claim.

- 7. The Claimant's remaining claims of direct sex discrimination are not well founded and are dismissed.
- 8. The Claimant's claims of victimisation are not well founded and are dismissed.
- 9. The Claimant's clam of wrongful dismissal is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 10. The Claimant's claims of unpaid holiday pay is not well founded and is dismissed.
