- 1. The claim was presented in the Employment Tribunal on 9th October 2024. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 22 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £3846.16 gross.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £2069.20.
- 4. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £1570.52.
- 5. The respondent must pay the claimant £7485.88 in total.
