Desk-top study

Condition:

A desk-top study shall be carried out by a competent person to identify and evaluate all potential sources and impacts of land and/or groundwater contamination relevant to the site. The desk-top study shall comply with BS10175:2011 + A2:2017 Investigation of Potentially Contaminated Sites – Code of Practice. Copies of the desk-top study shall be submitted to the LPA without delay on completion.

Reason:

To ensure that adequate protection of human health is maintained and the quality of the groundwater is protected. To comply with Policy 84 of the St Albans District Local Plan Review 1994.

Where a site is affected by contamination, responsibility for securing a safe development rests with the developer and/or landowner.
