As a resident of the local area, I am appealing against this planning application on the demolition of The Bull Inn to build flats.

The residents of Crews Hole and Troopers Hill are in desperate need for a local shop, cafe, community centre, bar/ restaurant. Local residents comment that there is a need for a community hub in the area. There are already several flats surrounding the pub with a growing population and increased traffic on Crews Hole Road since the bus gates have been placed in Barton Hill. It would be a shame to demolish a pub which is in a prime location with the potential to bring people together and reduce the number of cars on the road. Local residents have to get in their cars to drive to Church Road or Hanham to get a coffee and some basic supplies.
