Diplomacy

UK, with France, is leading efforts to build a 'Coalition of the Willing' to defend any peace deal and support Ukraine's future security

UK-Ukraine 100 Year Partnership fosters cross-sector collaboration incl. defence & security, science & tech, economy & trade [16 Jan]

Supported UNGA resolutions condemning Russia's: invasion [Feb 25, Feb 23, Mar 22]; attempted annexation of 4 Ukrainian regions [Oct 22]; & attacks on Ukraine's energy infrastructure [Jul 24]

We use the UNSC to hold Russia to account & reaffirm support for Ukraine. FS used Presidency to mark 1000 days of invasion [18 Nov]

At OSCE, we call out Russia weekly & co-fund Support Programme for Ukraine. 4 fact-finding missions reported on human rights abuses. At Reinforced Permanent Council we reiterated our support [24 Feb]

At IAEA, we support efforts towards nuclear safety in Ukraine

Military

£10.8bn total & £3bn a year for as long as it takes [10 Jul] £2.26bn contribution to G7 ERA Loans, to be repaid with profits from Russian assets. Two thirds now disbursed - 2nd £752m paid [14 Apr] UK therefore expects to provide £4.5bn total support in 2025 [16 Jan] Sent ~400 different capabilities to Ukraine incl. drones, tanks, boats, air defence, munitions & missiles. New £450m package for repairs & radar systems, anti-tank mines & drones - UK cont. = £350m [11 Apr] UK & Latvia-led drone coalition to deliver 30,000 new attack & surveillance drones [9 Jan]. Non-military

- £4.1bn in fiscal support through World Bank loan guarantees
- £977m in bilateral assistance. £282m in 2024/25 funds reform, humanitarian, energy, recovery & reconstruction programmes

Co-hosted Ukraine Recovery Conference 2023, raising over \$60bn War risk insurance via MIGA & EBRD boosts inward investment £3.5bn via UKEF for reconstruction, energy & defence projects, incl. reconstruction of 6 bridges & delivery of mine countermeasure vessels Up to £30m via British International Investment, working with EBRD to offer trade finance to support critical imports/exports [11 Sep] £38m Good Governance Fund tackles corruption & supports reform New £50m economic recovery programme helps SMEs [16 Jan]

Energy

Over £400m for energy security and resilience through grant, in-kind support and loan guarantees

A further £20m to support emergency energy needs takes total support to the Ukraine Energy Support Fund to £84m [17 Dec] £181m from UKEF for Urenco to supply enriched uranium to power

Ukraine & maintain its independence from Russian fuel [18 Jul]

£17m to support UK and Ukrainian innovators through a second round of UK's Innovate Ukraine Green Energy Competition [5 Feb]

Sanctions

>2,300 individuals and entities sanctioned, incl. >2,100 since full-scale invasion

UK, US and EU sanctions have deprived Russia of over \$450bn since Feb 2022 - equivalent to ~3 more years funding for the invasion Collective G7 sanctions have disrupted Russia's shadow fleet, which cost >\$10bn, & left vessels unable to trade. 129 oil tankers, 9 LNG carriers & 6 vessels transporting military goods sanctioned since July Russian oil revenues were down 27% in 2024 (Jan-Nov) compared to the same period in 2022

This Government has imposed sanctions against:

- <u>over 100 targets, incl. 40 oil tankers & military supply chains</u> our largest package in over 2 years [24 Feb]
- several high-profile individuals linked to Putin's inner circle [14 Feb]
- 2 of Russia's 4 largest oil companies, disrupting revenues [10 Jan]

Our military aid and insurance through the UK-developed <u>Unity facility</u> supported the Black Sea <u>maritime corridor</u> enabling Ukraine to <u>export</u> its goods, including all of its 2023 harvest.

UK-Ukraine Political, Free Trade & Strategic Partnership Agreement enables tariff free trade on all goods until 31 March 2029 (eggs & poultry until 31 March 2026) [8 Feb 2024]

Ukrainians in the UK

219,400 Ukrainians have arrived in the UK, including 160,500 via Homes for Ukraine [as of 30 Dec]
Ukraine Permission Extension Scheme opened 4 Feb 2025 [26 Nov]
