

Thank you for your response.

The submitted videos and photos illustrate the hazardous situation caused by HGVs parking and delivering goods to the Best One store at 10 Melvin Square. This presents a particular risk to preschool children, their parents, and other pedestrians using the nearby school located by the roundabout.

The footage also shows the difficulties faced by other road users, including buses, which are often delayed due to obstructed access when an HGV is parked at 1 llminster Avenue, right at the exit of the roundabout.

Furthermore, by granting permission for the construction of a large HMO with 16 single bedrooms, the Council risks making the area even more overcrowded. This would significantly increase existing safety hazards for pedestrians and road users alike.
