JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

Wages

- 1. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is well-founded. The respondent made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages in the period **29 June 2024 to 27 September 2024**.
- 2. The respondent shall pay the claimant £13,315.08, which is the gross sum deducted. The claimant is responsible for the payment of any tax or National Insurance.
- 3. The respondent shall also pay the claimant £200 to compensate the claimant for financial loss attributable to the unauthorised deduction.

Holiday Pay

4. The complaint in respect of holiday pay is dismissed.
