| Form completion | 2. Please complete the form in block letters in writing or typewriting using black ink not liable to smear. No covering letter is required and no plan or other document should be lodged in support of the application. |
| Particulars of subsisting registration | 3. Under s.32 of, and paragraph 2 of Schedule 4 to, the Family Law Act 1996 a charge in respect of home rights under the Act may be registered against one dwellinghouse only at any one time and the Chief Land Registrar will thus be bound to cancel any previous registration. |

The letter must certify that the applicant has applied for an official search of the index map at the appropriate HM Land Registry office. It must also contain an undertaking that he will apply to cancel this registration if he discovers from the result of search that the title to the land is registered. |
