- 1. The Respondents were in breach of contract for failing to pay three months' notice and are Ordered to pay: £17,499.00.
- 2. The Claimant is entitled to 18 days accrued holiday and the Respondents are Ordered to pay holiday pay in the sum of: £4,846.15.
- 3. The total award amounts to **£22,345.15** payable by the Respondents forthwith.
