# JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

The name of the Respondent is amended to Surrey County Council.

## Wages

1. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is well-founded. The respondent made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages in the period **April – May 2024** although the amount due has subsequently been paid.
2. The respondent shall also pay the claimant **£20** to compensate the claimant for financial loss attributable to the unauthorised deduction.
