Guidance

Office of the Public Guardian registers

The Office of the Public Guardian (OPG) maintains a register for guardianship orders.

Anyone can apply for a search of this register.

What you can find out

You can find out:

- whether a court order relates to the appointment of a guardian
- when a guardianship order became active
- the name of the person an order is about
- the date of birth of the person an order is about
- whether there are any restrictions in a court order (but not what they are)
- whether a court order is active, cancelled, revoked or expired
- a court order reference and OPG case reference number
- the expiry date of a guardianship court order

What you cannot find out

We will not be able to tell you:

- the name of the guardian or guardians
- information about applications for guardianship orders that are still in progress

What information you need to provide

You need to complete **sections 1 and 2** of this form.

We've put an asterisk (*) next to information you must provide.

Section 3 of this form is optional. It only needs to be completed if you want to ask for additional information about someone.

Additional information

In some cases we may consider an application for additional information we do not keep on the register.

To apply for additional information complete **section 3** of this form, stating:

- what information you need
- why you need this information

We'll consider each application on a case-by-case basis.
