JUDGMENT

- 1 The claimant's complaint of a failure to make reasonable adjustment succeeds.
- The claimant's complaint of unfavourable treatment because of something arising in connection with disability succeeds.
- The Tribunal awards the sum of £15,000 by way of injury to feelings (which is not in connection with the termination of employment).
- 4 Interest is awarded in the sum of £1200.
- 5 The total sum payable by the respondent to the claimant is £16,200.
