I am writing to object to the above application relating to the extension of Glenview Nursing Home in Belvedere Road from 40 to 52 beds. I live at [REDACTED], [REDACTED] from this proposed development.

The applicant has raised applications for this extension several times before, which have quite rightly been refused. I am asking that this new application is again rejected on the following grounds:

Ambulance parking in the middle of the road for extended periods happens on frequent occasions. Knowing this I always check before turning into the road, but many drivers hope to be able to pass, and end up reversing back down the road, some of these of course backwards on to the busy Westbury road. There are also food delivery vans which again block the road for lengthy periods.

Littering of the street. I have spent some time collecting leaves from the gutters along Belvedere road and have encountered many items of medical waste, mostly disposable gloves, that have blown out of the overflowing waste bins.

Parking in the area is always a problem, a point covered in other correspondence at length. There are frequently cars parked across driveways or on street corners, causing difficulty for traffic to navigate safely.

I endorse the extensive comments made by [REDACTED] in relation to this application and also [REDACTED], which I completely support as a valid and accurate record of the current difficulties caused by the care home.

If you are minded to accept this application, could I please request that a public hearing is held to allow residents to state their thoughts and experiences.
