To whom it may concern.

I am writing to object to application reference S62A/2025/01017 relating to the extension of Glenview Nursing Home in Belvedere Road from 40 to 52 beds.

I have been living in this area for more than 10 years and parking has always been a constant problem, forcing me to park innumerable times extremely far. But it got pretty bad since the Residents Parking Zone got established nearby in 2016, and even worse since Glenview Nursing Home opened in 2018 in 8-9 Belvedere Road. During the time when houses at 8-9 Belvedere Road got renovated to build the Glenview Nursing Home, the parking situation got really out of control.

As I live [REDACTED], throughout the week I regularly notice cars parked at the corner or on the curb because of lack of parking space. They disrupt not only pedestrian passage, but also rubbish collection. I have stopped counting the number of times that the city has not collected my rubbish because not in plain sight. With the addition of additional beds at the Nursing homes, with more visitors and subsequent less parking, these scenarios will only get worse and more frequent.

Finally, let me add that If PINS is minded to approve this application, then I would request a hearing where I and other residents can attend in person to present our statements and experiences.
