I am writing to object to the planned extension to the Glenview Nursing Home at 7 <u>Belvedere Road, Bristol</u> BS6 7JG. This is application reference S62A/2025/0101. Our daughter and her family live on Belvedere Road and we are witness to the impact having such an overly intensified provision of care beds on the street has on their lives, and the lives of their community.

We provide childcare for our two young grandchildren and often find that we are unable to park, or access the street to park, due to blockages caused by ambulances and delivery vans at these nursing homes. Access to our daughter's driveway is often blocked by parked cars, preventing us from accessing it, and the situation has increased in recent years. We have, on multiple occasions, been unable to park near their house or anywhere on Belvedere Road, forcing us to have to park at a distance and walk.

Our daughter has missed a number of family events due to issues with vehicles connected to the care homes blocking their car in the driveway, and we have on a number of occasions helped in an emergency to pick up and take her and our grandchildren to appointments when she has been unable to move her car. The increase in more care facilities on the road will only make this situation worse and intolerable for her and anyone living on the street.

It seems unfair that the intensification of more, or larger, care homes is placed on one neighbourhood to bear.
