Dear Planning Inspectorate,

I am writing to object to the proposed extension of the care home at 7 Belvedere Road, Bristol (Application S62A/2025/0101).

This proposal would increase care home capacity by 30%, placing further pressure on an already congested residential street. Parking is consistently difficult, with staff and visitors frequently occupying spaces, and blocking driveways during shift changes and deliveries. I have personally experienced regular issues parking near my home and have had to park several streets away, even during off-peak times.

Noise and disruption are already considerable – including late-night disturbances from residents and frequent ambulance visits. Increasing capacity will only make this worse. The current infrastructure cannot support more traffic, emergency vehicles, or refuse services.

I also request that, should the application be approved, a public hearing be held so that local residents may present our concerns directly.

Please give full consideration to the impact this development will have on the wellbeing of residents and the character of our street.
