

## Examples of when the new five-year accreditation period for the Specialist Quality Mark will apply to applications for accreditation and reaccreditation

## Overview

From 1 October 2025, the Specialist Quality Mark (SQM) accreditation period will be increasing from 3 years to 5 years. The new accreditation period will apply to any SQM where a Pre-Quality Mark Audit or Post-Quality Mark Audit takes place on or after 1 October 2025. SQM accreditation awarded or renewed in these circumstances will last 5 years instead of 3 years.

This document provides worked examples of when the new 5-year accreditation period does and does not apply to help individuals understand these rules.

## **Examples**

Scenario	Outcome
A new Applicant passes the Desktop Audit on 1 May 2025. The Provider applies for Pre-Quality Mark Audit on 15 August 2025.	The SQM is awarded for <b>5 years</b> from 8 October 2025
The Pre-Quality Mark Audit takes place on 3 October 2025.	
The Provider is awarded the SQM on 8 October 2025.	
The Provider applies for Pre-Quality Mark Audit on 1 August 2025.	The SQM is awarded for <b>5 years</b> from 10 October 2025.
The Pre-Quality Mark Audit is due to take place on 15 September 2025.	
However, the audit is delayed and takes place on 5 October 2025 instead.	



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The SQM is awarded for <b>3 years</b> from 16 October 2025.
The SQM is awarded for <b>3 years</b> from 13 October 2025.
