## JUDGMENT

1. By agreement, under Rule 35 of the Employment Tribunal Procedure Rules 2024, the respondent's name is amended to that of the claimant's employer.
2. The respondent admitted liability for one day's holiday pay that was incorrectly added to the claimant's 2024 leave year.
3. The respondent shall pay the claimant £133.46, which is the gross sum deducted. The claimant is responsible for the payment of any tax or National Insurance.
