Thank you for your email of 24 March 2025 in which you requested from the Insolvency Service (the agency):

- "- During the financial year of 2023/2024 how many Lawyers worked at the Insolvency Service as either LOCUM contractor or were introduced by an agency on a Fixed term Contract basis?
- During the financial year 2023/2024 how many permanent Lawyers started in the Insolvency Service and were introduced through an agency?"

Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

I can confirm the agency holds the information that you have requested, and I have provided answers to your questions below:

During the financial year of 2023/2024 how many Lawyers worked at the Insolvency Service as either LOCUM contractor or were introduced by an agency on a Fixed term Contract basis?

During 2023/24, 5 x lawyers worked at INSS on a fixed term appointment (FTA) basis after an external FTA recruitment campaign was run.

During the financial year 2023/2024 how many permanent Lawyers started in the Insolvency Service and were introduced through an agency?

During 2023/24, 8 x permanent lawyers started at INSS after external permanent recruitment campaigns were run. However these individuals were not introduced through an agency.
