The commander was landing on tarmac Runway 27 on a gusty day; the wind was from 240° at 18 gusting to 29 kt. Theapproach was uneventful but he noticed marked windshear at about10 feet above the runway. After a normal touchdown the aircraftunexpectedly became airborne once more and it developed a porpoisingmotion in pitch which culminated in quite a heavy touchdown. At that stage the commander was unaware of any damage to the aircraftbut after shutting down on the apron he noticed that the tipsof all three blades on the right propeller were bent backwardsby some two inches. There was no other visible damage to theaircraft.
