#### Irregularity Statement as required by sub section 6 (a) of the Act

We are required by the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 (amended) to include the following declaration in this statement to all members. The wording is as prescribed by the Act.

"A member who is concerned that some irregularity may be occurring, or have occurred, in the conduct of the financial affairs of the union may take steps with a view to investigating further, obtaining clarification and, if necessary, securing regularisation of that conduct.

The member may raise any such concerns with such one or more of the following as it seems appropriate to raise it with: the officials of the union, the trustees of the property of the union, the auditor or auditors of the union, the Certification Officer (who is an independent officer appointed by the Secretary of State) and the police.

Where a member believes that the financial affairs of the union have been or are being conducted in breach of the law or in breach of rules of the union and contemplates bringing civil proceedings against the union or responsible officials or trustees, he should consider obtaining independent legal advice."

#### **Reporting on Summarised Accounts**

The above summarised financial statements are extracted from the full statutory annual report and financial statements which were approved by and signed on their behalf on 14<sup>th</sup> May 2025. The full financial statements, on which the auditors Crowe U.K. LLP gave an unqualified audit report on 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2025, have been submitted to the Certification Officer on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2025.

The auditors have confirmed to National Executive that, in their opinion, the summarised financial statements are consistent with the full financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024.
