DECLARATION OF SPECIAL MEASURES: IMPORTATION OF UNTREATED WOOL AND HAIR FROM ESWATINI, HUNGARY AND SLOVAKIA

THE TRADE IN ANIMALS AND RELATED PRODUCTS REGULATIONS 2011 (SI 2011/1197)

The Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs has reasonable grounds for suspecting the existence of foot-and-mouth disease in Eswatini, Hungary and Slovakia such that certain animal by-products originating in Eswatini, Hungary and Slovakia are liable to pose a risk to animal health.

Under regulation 29(1) of the Trade in Animals and Related Products Regulations 2011¹, the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs declares the following special measures to be necessary in England in order to contain the risk to animal health.

Amendment of the existing declaration

- 1. The Declaration of Special Measures: importation of untreated wool and hair of susceptible animals from certain third countries and territories made by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs on 16 January 2025² ("the Declaration") is amended in accordance with paragraph 2.
- 2. In the Declaration
 - a. in Annex 1. in the table
 - i. omit "27. Eswatini";
 - ii. omit "37. Hungary";
 - iii. omit "67. Slovakia"; and
 - iv. insert "78. Germany".

Revocation of previous measures

3. The "Declaration of Special Measures: Importation of Untreated Wool and Hair of Susceptible Animals from Hungary, Austria and Slovakia" made 14 May 2025 is revoked.

Coming into force of the Declaration

4. The revocation in paragraph 3 and the special measures in this Declaration come into force on the day following the day on which the Declaration is made.
