I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that:

With regard to Foot and Mouth disease (FMD):

- (a) the exporting country and the country/zone of origin of the animals from which the meat and offal¹ is derived has/have been free from FMD as officially recognised by the WOAH prior to the date of the slaughter of the animals and the date of issue of this certificate;
- (b) *where the exporting country and the country/zone of origin of the animals from which the meat and offal¹ is derived is free of FMD with vaccination, the products described above for export to Singapore do not include any part of the head, including the pharynx, tongue, and associated lymph nodes;
- (c) *where the exporting country and the country/zone of origin of the animals from which the meat and offal¹ is derived is an FMD-affected country/zone, the products described above for export to Singapore have

been subjected to heat treatment that is sufficient for inactivation of FMD virus in accordance with WOAH quidelines.

With regard to Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE):

(d) *FOR MEAT DERIVED FROM CATTLE BORN AND RAISED IN A COUNTRY/ZONE WITH A NEGLIGIBLE BSE RISK

(f) *FOR MEAT DERIVED FROM CATTLE BORN AND RAISED IN A COUNTRY/ZONE WITH UNDETERMINED RISK:

- (i) The meat was derived from cattle that have not been fed meat-andbone meal or greaves derived from ruminants
- (ii) The meat was produced in a manner which ensures the products listed above do not contain and are not contaminated with:
 - a) Brain, eye, spinal cord, skull and vertebral column from cattle 12 months and older, and the distal ileum and tonsils from all cattle
 - b) Nervous or lymphatic tissue exposed during the deboning process
 - c) Mechanically separated meat from the skull and vertebral column from cattle over 12 months of age;
- (g) the exporting country and the country/zone of origin of the animals from which the meat is derived has/have a reliable system of traceability in place;
- (h) the products have not been derived from suspect or confirmed BSE cases, or suspect or confirmed progeny or cohorts of BSE cases, as described in the Terrestrial Animal Health Code;

(i) the products have been derived from cattle that were not subjected to a stunning process with a device injecting compressed air or gas into the cranial cavity, or to a pithing process;

Additional Statements:

- (j) the products described above were prepared in an establishment accredited by the SFA and is audited regularly by the competent authority of the exporting country for compliance with conditions for import into Singapore;
- (k) the products described above were derived from cattle that were born and raised in *England, *Wales, *Scotland, *Northern Ireland and/or *the Republic of Ireland;
- (1) the meat has been derived from animals which have passed ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection and found to be free from infectious and contagious diseases. Ante-mortem and post-mortem inspections have been carried out by veterinarians or meat inspectors under direct supervision of government veterinarians;
- (m) the animals from which the meat was derived were slaughtered and the meat processed, packed and stored in sanitary conditions under official veterinary supervision in establishments approved by the Director-General, Food Administration, for export to Singapore;
- (n) the meat described above has not been treated with chemical preservatives or other substances injurious to health;
- (o) the meat described above was inspected and found fit for human consumption. Every precaution has been taken to prevent contamination prior to export.

Retort processed meat products (e.g. canned meat) have been heat treated (sterilising process with sterilising value of not less than Fo3) to commercial sterility in hermetically sealed containers and are shelf stable at ambient temperatures;

(q) The processed products have not been subject to any form of pathogen reduction treatment (PRT). Any PRTs used for unprocessed meat must be approved by the SFA in addition to proper hygiene practices, and have not been used to treat contaminated meat.
