JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under Employment Tribunal Rule 38(1)(d) because it has not been actively pursued.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated 30 April 2025 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out because:
 - The claimant had not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated 13 January 2025.
 - It has not been actively pursued.
2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The claim is therefore struck out.
