



What does the rule relate to?	Rule	Live example (before and after)
Textual data - Addresses	Addresses have been populated for all charges.	<p>Before: Some charges would only have an address referenced in the description of the charge.</p> <p>After: All charges have addresses or a geographic description of the affected land.</p>
Textual data - Charge types and sub-categories	All charges in the register now contain a charge type and a sub-category in accordance with the HMLR schema.	<p>Before: Subtype = miscellaneous</p> <p>After: charge-type = Housing / buildings charge-sub-category = Works, repairs or authority action (Example of a previous miscellaneous part 4 charge)</p>
Textual data - Originating authority	The originating authority for ancient monuments is now set to "Historic England"	<p>Before: Oadby and Wigston Borough Council</p> <p>After: Historic England</p>
Textual data - Originating authority	The originating authority name is now more consistent.	<p>Before: Oadby and Wigston Borough Council or Oadby & Wigston Borough Council</p> <p>After: Oadby and Wigston Borough Council</p>
Textual data – Financial charges	Where the interest rate and/ or value of the financial charge was missing. The charge now shows 0 as the amount and/or rate of interest.	<p>Before:</p> <p>After: 0</p>
Revealing a TPO charge	TPO's will only be revealed if they are covered by the search extent.	<p>Before: A degree of flexibility allows TPO's sitting outside the search extent to be revealed on a search result.</p> <p>After: The search result would only reveal a charge that is included in the extent search area.</p>
